Monday – Thursday

Tops:

Elementary School Students:

- burgundy Blake Academy logo polo shirt with collar

Middle School Students:

- sapphire Blake Academy logo polo shirt with collar
- burgundy Blake Academy logo polo shirt with collar

**2018-2019- Will be a transition year for the middle school uniform top color change allowing students to wear either color.*

Bottoms (Elementary & Middle):

- Khaki/tan twill pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers

FRIDAY

Tops:

Elementary School Students:

- Blake Academy polo shirt with collar (burgundy polo with Blake Academy logo)
- Friday tee shirt (any Blake Academy tee shirt)

Middle School Students:

- Blake Academy polo shirt with collar (sapphire/burgundy polo with Blake Academy logo)
- Friday tee shirt (any Blake Academy tee shirt)

Bottoms (Elementary & Middle):

- Shorts, pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers
- Khaki/tan twill pants or shorts or dark blue denim jeans or shorts

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Shirts will be tucked in at all times
- Pants will be hemmed – no cut-offs or frayed edges – free from tears/holes
- Belts will be worn at all times if the garment has belt loops
- Shorts, skirts, skorts or jumpers will be no shorter than finger-tip length
- Shoes will be closed toe and closed heel – NO high heels, flip-flops or bedroom slippers
- No bibbed overall pants or shorts
- Clothing will be the appropriate size
- Natural hair color only
- No bandanas
- No body piercings

Cold weather clothing that is acceptable in the classroom:

- Blake hooded sweatshirts (BLACK) -- hood will remain off during class and inside buildings
- Any jacket/coat/sweater that opens all the way down the front (BLACK ONLY)
- Leggings may be worn under skirts, skorts or jumpers (BLACK, GREY, or WHITE ONLY)

PE Uniform that is acceptable if student chooses to dress out:

- Gray tee shirt (solid color, no logos, no spandex)
- Black shorts (solid color /no logos, no spandex)
